cafe. Walk-ins are welcome, but appointments are preferred. Call the school for an appointment if you haven't been contacted.

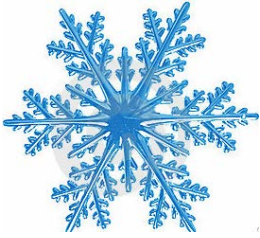

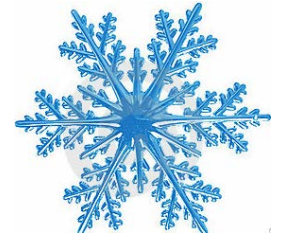
