Starmont Community School District Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER III) Plan

Starting Revenue Allotment: American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act Reservation

The total amount allocated to the district is \$779,000. The LEA (district) must reserve at least 20% of the funds to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions (e.g., summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day(s), comprehensive after school programs, extended school year programs and ensure that those interventions respond to students’ social, emotional, and academic needs and address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student subgroups (i.e. each major racial and ethnic group, children from low-income families, children with disabilities, English learners, migrant students, students experiencing homelessness, children and youth in foster care).

Allowable Uses

The ESSER III fund, like the ESSER I and ESSER II funds, may be used by PK-12 schools for a broad set of possible purposes, with substantially local authority and discretion in prioritizing relief spending. This is similar to the permitted uses of ESSER II under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act and use of ESSER I.
