We would like to send you a quick memo in regards to school registration for the upcoming school year. Registration will take place **online** again this year from August 7th-August 11th. There will be in-person registration <u>August 7 in the High School Café from 1:00-7:00 PM</u>. We will be taking payments that day as well. Registration will still take place online, with Chromebooks set up and people to assist on that day. Transportation, Nurse, Booster Club and SMA will also be present. Please take this time to come and meet our new Superintendent and MS/HS principal.

School pictures will still be taken in the fall during school hours.

Please understand if you do not complete online registration, we will not know to issue your student a chromebook. Chromebooks will only be issued upon completion of all online registration forms.
